

to East Peak

Start the hike here – at the drinking fountain on the east side of the theater. Get hike directions and a snack.

Amphitheater

1 Lighten your load. Drop off coolers, cushions, etc to the right of the stage for transport down to Mill Valley.

3 Note the expansive vistas and beautiful green serpentine rock, the same rock mined for our theater seating.

4 The West Point Inn, built in 1904, offers lemonade, maps and restrooms.

5 Descend on Nora Trail – steep and rocky – be careful.

6 Intersect the Mott Davis Trail – travel one mile on gentle slopes

7 Trail widens – go down the Hogback, a fire road with stunning vistas then continue past fire station for Porta Potties and water.

8 Stop for refreshments at Mountain Home Inn, built in 1912.
